A Quick Guide to the PASR WEBSITE: http://www.pasr.org

Follow these easy steps to navigate through the PASR state website to find SSMHF materials and to connect to newsletters to see what is happening across the state of PA.

1. Go to your web search engine and enter the web address: http://www.pasr.org

(Chrome is a very good search engine to use if loaded on your computer or smart phone.)

2. As members, you are required to enter your user name. This is the member number found on all PASR mailings from state and located above your name. You may have to call the state office for your membership number if you do not have a publication copy. When a publication arrives, save your address that contains this number. The PASR State phone number is **1-717-697-7077** just in case.

3. You must also enter your password. This is the first initial of your first name and your entire last name, all in lower case with no spaces. You may reset your password only when you feel confident. By entering your email address and pressing: *retrieve password*, PASR will email your reset password to you.

4. Once you have logged in, the world of PASR is at your fingertips and ready for you to navigate and have fun.

5. All publications are located under the subtitle: Member Publications in the left margin. Please click on the words: **member publications.**

6. Under publications, you will find two SSMHF subtitles. Forms that you need to use to fulfill your responsibilities as the SSMHF chair for your local/regions are found under the first subtitle: **Handbooks-Social Service Memorial Honor Fund Handbook.** These forms include Donation forms for SSMHF, annual report forms for SSMHF, forms to apply for grants, forms to apply for financial help with state dues, forms to report ways you have spent money from SSMHF, and any form that is in the SSMHF packet given out at the SSMHF convention workshop.

7. Further down the publications list, you will find all memorial materials that you can use for your memorial services: poems, ideas, etc. under the heading: Member Materials and Forms-SSMHF memorial service readings

8. The SSMHF Report Form is under its own heading.

9. Interested in reading the newsletters from other locals, scroll down publications until you find newsletter, then click on it to find local newsletters from various regions.

10. Many locals have websites that you can navigate to from the state site with a simple click of your mouse or tap of your finger.

11. Relax and explore the PASR website for ideas, forms, and materials.

All Venango PASR members with computers need to log on the the PASR state site. We need 25 members who have not previously logged on to visit the site so PASR/Venango can meet the goal set by state. A page of easy to follow directions is located in this newsletter. VISIT : *www.pasr.org*

Sharon Mylarski is our Birthday Card sender for all our members. These girls spend many hours making sure that our members are receiving services. Over 270 Birthday cards have been sent throughout the year. We have distributed 23 gifts in December and 22 gifts in May to our homebound members and nursing home members. Over 220 additional cards have been sent over the year to members who need to know someone cares.

If you know or hear of a Venango County PASR member who is hospitalized or , gone to a nursing home, or is having major surgery or cancer, please notify one of us immediately: Diana (676-6442) Sandy (432-4450), Linda (677-2739), Sandra (677-4953), or Gloria (676-9372). Leave a message if you cannot reach one of us. We would love to send them a get-well card from their PASR friends. Cut flowers or a planter may also be sent.

Upon the death of a member, our treasurer makes a monetary donation to the SSMHF state fund and a card notifies the family that a contribution has been made to the fund in the name of the deceased. Anyone who desires to make an individual gift to SSMHF in memory or honor of a member may do so by contacting Diana (676-6442) or using the form in this newsletter.

When a member turn 90, become homebound, or is a resident of a nursing home, Venango PASR SSMHF committee sends additional cards five or more times a year. In May and December, the committee buys these members small gifts to be personally delivered or mailed due to distance. We do not want our older members feeling forgotten.

Sharon Mylarski has kindly agreed to volunteer her time to make sure that every member of PASR Venango County receives a birthday card on their own birthday. Many thanks for her long-time dedication to ensuring every member's birthday is special!
