Report for PASR Region 9 Director and PASR Venango Vice President Diana Fesenmyer

PASR-Venango has invited guests from PASR- Clarion to visit us at our Fall Meeting and our Christmas Party. Please extend a warm welcome to these members. I have been traveling three to four times to the monthly meetings of PASR-Erie in 2023. I have traveled to PASR Warren/Forest three times to their meetings. Every second month since 2022 (POST COVID) I have been to PASR Crawford's meetings. We are seeing many PASR chapters across Pennsylvania unable to find leadership or volunteers to fill positions.

Many members across Pennsylvania feel they have already helped or held offices. Some even say it is time for the younger members to take over! This trend is common in other organizations like the ELKS, Moose Club, BPW/PA, and even School Boards.

Unlike these other organizations, PASR is a group of retired school employees. We have worked 25 to 30 to 40 years in schools with children, teachers, custodians, cafeteria workers, maintenance people, administration and principals. An eight-hour day was a reward. Many hours would be given to grading, room and lesson preparation, cleaning, mopping, and checking on our co-workers and our students. Many times, the cafeteria staff would let us know that kids were going hungry so we could help fund a meal or two. If a family lost everything in a fire, we were there to help with coats, shoes, and necessities. When I could not get out of my driveway due to snow, a former student would plow me out and say this was his way of saying thanks for helping when he needed help. PASR school employees need help across Pennsylvania.

I must have done something right! My two daughters became teachers, and spend hours a day helping children, teachers, and staff in their buildings. They even help me when I need help setting up a PASR picnic. We each have our stories and need to share our memories at our Chapter meetings.
